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## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

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This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used, it includes both sexes.

Entries close at 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 10, 2016 at the Trial Secretary's Office, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or altered except as may be specifically provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2). A RECORDING FEE of \$3.50 is required for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry at any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial.

Exhibitors indemnify Purina, the affiliated person/s or businesses conducting the Show or Trial, against any and all claims of arising that may be leveled against them, jointly or severally, in respect to any damage, injury or loss to persons, pets and/or property.

POST DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES with checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with International money orders in U.S. Funds.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable after entries close with confirmation and judging programs. Should such acknowledgement not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable amount of time, please notify Trial Secretary.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIANS' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

CRATING will be available along the west wall of the Great Hall in the Purina Farms Event Center. All crates must be on a solid type of matting that won't allow liquids or other substances to seep through on to the floor.

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED in the restrooms or concession area.

TRANSFERS WILL BE ALLOWED at this trial per AKC Regulations, provided that written notification is made to the trial secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the trial. Transfers will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.
